Dr. Kim Lane Scheppele is Laurance S. Rockefeller Professor of Sociology and International Affairs at the Woodrow Wilson School and Director of the Program in Law and Public Affairs at Princeton University. Dr. Scheppele is one of the world's foremost authorities on the intersection of constitutional and international law, particularly in constitutional systems under stress.

Dr. Andras Bozoki is Professor of Political Science at the Central European University in Budapest, Hungary. He is currently Visiting Professor at Columbia University. His work focuses on democratization, political ideas, Central European politics, elites, public discourse and the role of intellectuals. He served as Minister of Culture in Hungary in 2005-2006.

Dr András *B.* Göllner is Professor Emeritus in the Department of Political Science at Concordia University. His area of expertise is democratic governance, political communication and international relations. He is also a civil rights activist, and serves as the International Spokesperson of the Canadian Hungarian Democratic Charter.
